The new Centre of Social Services Raval is a facility that covers more than 49,000 people around the neighbourhood. Its facilities, over 1,800 square meters, are equipped with all necessary services to properly care for users and to enable its approximately 40 professionals to work. The building in which it is located is classified as historical heritage. However, it has been necessary to rehabilitate because it was badly damaged. It was built in the nineteenth century and housed the School of the Republic.
